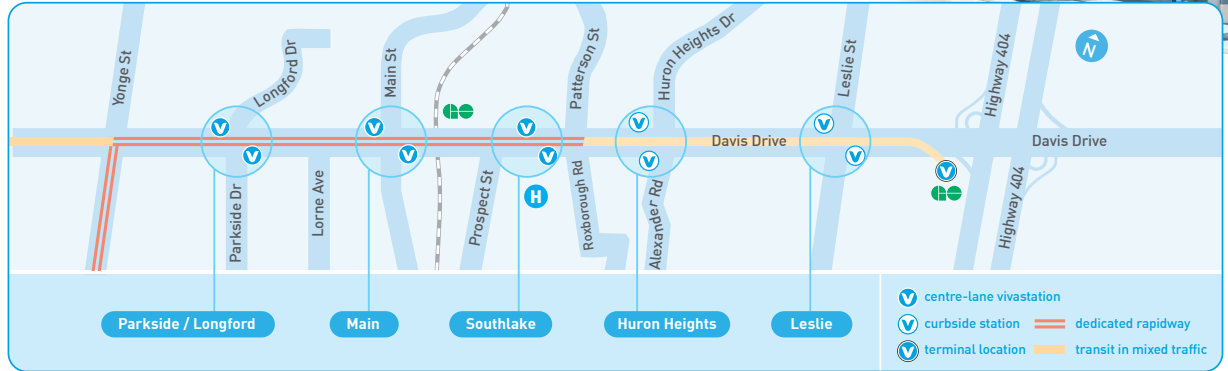




VIVAnext rapidway on davis drive



Location and length

- Town of Newmarket on Davis Drive.
- 2.7 kilometres on Davis Drive from Yonge Street to Roxborough Road/Patterson Street.

funding

- Funded by Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, as part of their \$1.4 billion commitment to improving transit in York Region.

station information

- Three centre-lane vivastations at Parkside/Longford, Main, and Southlake Regional Health Centre.
- Two curb-side stations at Alexander/Huron Heights and Leslie.
- A vivastation will be built at Yonge Street and Davis Drive as part of a vivaNext Yonge Street rapidway project.

connections

- Viva vehicles travelling the Davis Drive rapidway will connect with YRT, viva and GO buses at the Newmarket Bus Terminal, and GO trains and buses at the Newmarket GO Station (The Tannery), before continuing to Highway 404.
- Customers travelling the Davis Drive rapidway will also connect with Yonge Street viva routes to Richmond Hill Centre Terminal and Finch Subway Station.

timelines

- Construction began in 2012 and substantial completion is scheduled for December 2015.

unique facts

- The Davis Drive rapidway intersects with the Tom Taylor Trail, and the project includes widening the Keith Bridge near The Tannery, and moving the historic Union Hotel farther back from the road.
