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Transport Canada has reviewed the *Identification of Federal Environmental Assessment Requirements Form* completed by the Toronto-York Spadina Subway Extension project submitted on September 29, 2009 for the Highway 407 Station and the associated infrastructure works and has determined that the project meets the exclusion criteria outlined in the Exclusion List Regulations, 2007 for the proposed construction, installation, operation, expansion or modification of a public transit facility. Therefore, the project as proposed does not require an environmental assessment under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*.

It is important to note that the determination is only applicable to the project as submitted for review. In addition, should the project change or vary from the project at the time the *Identification of Federal Environmental Assessment Requirements Form* was submitted, the Proponent is responsible for notifying Transport Canada of these changes if they may impact the determination of exclusion.

Please be advised that while the project is exempted from federal environmental assessment requirements, the project is still subject to any other federal, provincial and municipal authorizations that are required. For the project to proceed, authorizations must be obtained in a timely manner and the work must be carried out in accordance with the terms and conditions of these approvals.

The completed form indicates that the project is likely to involve in-water works. We are aware that you are currently in discussions with the Department of Fisheries and Oceans and the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority with respect to these works and expect that through that process any relevant permits or authorizations will be obtained.

Highway 407 Station is a major intermodal station and will incorporate an 18 bay bus terminal, a 600 space commuter parking lot, 30 space passenger pickup/drop-off (PPUDO) and will be designed to provide access to the future MTO Highway 407 Transitway. Access to the bus terminal and parking lot will be facilitated by a new bridge structure spanning Black Creek, which will be realigned around the station box. Highway 407 Station will be the site of Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) launch shafts for the tunnels at each end of the station. The subway will extend in twin bored tunnels from the north end of Highway 407 Station, north to Vaughan Corporate Centre Station and also from the south end of the station box southerly to Steeles West Station. The Highway 407 Station and the adjacent tunnel segments will be constructed under a single construction contract.
