



### project description

- An 11-bay bus terminal for YRT and Viva buses, with provisions for GO Transit and Durham Regional Transit in the future.
- A transit hub within walking distance to Markham-Stouffville Hospital and Cornell Community Centre & Library.

### project status & timeline

- Cornell Bus Terminal to be located on lands at Highway 7 and Ninth Line, just south of Markham-Stouffville Hospital.
- Engineering and design is complete.
- Construction scheduled to start this summer, and be completed by end of 2019.

### key benefits & features

- Provides a comfortable location for transit customers to arrive, transfer and depart, within a short walk of the hospital and community centre.
- Connects the Cornell neighbourhood with Viva rapid transit and amenities along Highway 7, to the rest of Markham and York Region.
- Attractive, modern design including a plaza for pedestrians to gather, retail amenities and a passenger pick-up and drop-off area.
- Design principles:
  - Create a sense of placemaking with strong visual presence on all sides.
  - Uses a warm material palette.
