rapidway on Yonge Street in Richmond Hill

location

- City of Richmond Hill.
- Yonge Street, from Highway 7 to 19th Avenue/Gamble Road.

funding

- Funded by Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, as part of their \$1.8 billion [2017 dollars] commitment to improving transit in York Region.

length and station information

- 6.5 kilometres.
- 7 centre-lane vivastations at Bantry/Scott, 16th/Carrville, Weldrick, Major Mackenzie, Elgin Mills, Bernard and 19th/Gamble.

connections

- Buses headed south on Yonge will connect with the Richmond Hill Centre Terminal, which meet up with routes in Vaughan and Markham, and the future Yonge North Subway Extension.
- Buses headed north on Yonge will connect with the Newmarket Bus Terminal, which meet up with the Davis Drive rapidway, offering connections to the Newmarket GO Station, Southlake Regional Health Centre, and will continue to the Highway 404 Park & Ride.

timelines

- Preliminary construction activities began in 2014. The rapidway is scheduled to open in 2020.

unique attributes

- To preserve the heritage area between Major Mackenzie and Levendale, in this section Viva will continue to drive in mixed traffic as it does now.
- Throughout Richmond Hill there will be raised and on street bike lanes on Yonge.
