

location

- Town of Newmarket.
- Yonge Street from Savage Road/Sawmill Valley Drive to Davis Drive.

funding

• Funded by Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, as part of their \$1.4 billion [2009 dollars] commitment to improving transit in York Region.

length and station information

- 2.4 kilometres.
- 3 centre-lane vivastations at Mulock, Eagle and Davis.

connections

- Buses headed south on Yonge will connect with the Richmond Hill Centre Terminal, which connects with routes in Vaughan and Markham, and the future Yonge Subway Extension.
- Buses headed north on Yonge will connect with the Newmarket Go Bus Terminal, which meet up with the Davis Drive rapidway, offering connections to the Newmarket GO Station, Southlake Regional Health Centre, and will continue to the Highway 404 Park & Ride.

timelines

• Preliminary construction activities began in 2014. The rapidway is scheduled to open in 2019.

unique attributes

- This section of Yonge will stop near York Region's headquarters and the Newmarket Provincial Court buildings at Eagle Street, near the Upper Canada Mall at Davis Drive and will connect to the Davis Drive rapidway.
- Along Yonge in Newmarket, there will be raised bike lanes.
