



location

- Town of Newmarket
- Yonge Street from Savage Road/Sawmill Valley Drive to Davis Drive

funding

- Funded by Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, as part of their \$1.4 billion [2009 dollars] commitment to improving transit in York Region

length and station information

- 2.4 kilometres from Savage/Sawmill Valley to Davis
- 3 centre-lane vivastations at Mulock, Eagle and Davis

connections

- Viva vehicles travelling the Yonge Street rapidway will connect with YRT, Viva and GO buses at the Newmarket Bus Terminal and Richmond Hill Centre, and customers will be able to transfer to TTC subway and buses at Finch Subway Station
- Vehicles will turn along the Davis Drive rapidway to connect with GO trains and buses at the Newmarket GO Station and will continue to Highway 404

timelines

- Preliminary construction activities began in 2014. The rapidway is scheduled to open in 2019

unique attributes

- This section of Yonge Street will stop at York Region’s headquarters, the Newmarket Provincial Court buildings at Eagle Street, near the Upper Canada Mall at Davis Drive and will connect to the Davis Drive rapidway
