- There will be multiple activities on the connector road between Bathurst Street and Highway 7 this weekend.
- The connector road will be closed with no access between Bathurst and Highway 7, beginning Friday night until early Monday morning.
- The connector road will reopen by 5am Monday morning with only the eastbound curb lane remaining closed.
- Detour signs to indicate alternate routes will be posted.
- There will be construction-related noise from equipment and trucks.
- Please give yourself enough time to get to your destination, and remember to reduce your speed through construction zones.
